This activity will be a great opportunity for you to work hand in hand with your son/daughter while also helping out with the embellishment and upkeep of their environment. You will be able to enjoy a visit to the Centre's garden while also learning and exchanging knowledge about gardening skills. Your attendance is highly recommended.

The first activity will take place on **Tuesday 25th October** between **9:30 and 12.15 am.** Transport will be available from near Scotts Supermarket, Burmarrad at 9:15am and to Valletta at the end of the activity.
